

## **SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED IN THE SCHOOL OF SURVEYING AND SPATIAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS**

### **Co-op Scholarships**

The UNSW Co-op Program is a scholarship program setup by industry and the University to provide money and industry training for selected undergraduate students. Co-op Scholars receive a tax-free scholarship of \$13,400 per annum and undertake two 10-week and two 24-week industry training placements during the course of their degree program. Students with a UAI of 95 may apply. Applications close on September 30.

### **Rural Scholarship**

The Faculty of Engineering Rural Scholarships Program is designed to assist students living in rural or isolated areas to study at UNSW. Rural Scholars receive a tax-free scholarship of \$8,500 per annum available for four years. Students with a UAI of 90 may apply. Applications close on September 30.

### **RTA Scholarship**

The Roads & Transport Authority Scholarships have been established to encourage students to undertake studies in the School of Surveying and SIS and approved industrial training at the RTA. RTA Scholars receive a tax-free scholarship of \$13,500 per annum available for four years and undertake three 10-week blocks of Industrial Training over the vacation period at the end of years 1, 2 and 3. Applications close on September 30.

### **The Surveyor General's Scholarship for Women in Surveying**

The scholarship, worth \$2000 for one year only, is available to a female student entering first year of the full-time degree program in Surveying and Spatial Information Systems at UNSW. Selection will be based on academic merit. Applications close 31 March.

### **The Surveyor General's Undergraduate Scholarship in Surveying & SIS**

Applicants must be in 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the Bachelor of Engineering (Surveying and Spatial Information Systems) program. The scholarship of \$14,000 for 1 year is paid while the student is undertaking his/her final year study. In addition, the NSW Dept. of Lands commits to employing the successful applicant for the year following graduation. Applications close 31 August.
